Preparedness Branch

Control Objectives

- Assess and monitor licensed Skilled Nursing Facilities (SNFs) for prevention, response, recovery and mitigation protocols.
- Ensure collaborative assessment of current resources with Human Services Department (HSD) regarding Sheltering to identify current and projected gaps; procure support and resources to mitigate gaps.
- Provide Just-in-Time personal and job-site preparedness training with emphasis on Behavioral Health and Psychological First Aid for ongoing altered conditions due to COVID-19.

Preparedness Branch

Control Objectives (cont.)

- Provide consistent assessment and monitoring of Senior Living settings that are additional elder housing beyond the seven licensed SNFs.
- Assess and monitor additional congregate living facilities for prevention and mitigation processes to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Steps in motion

- 1. Assess with partners current situation status, gaps and actions steps for mitigation
- 2. Pivot from traditional response mode to sustained response
- 3. Integration of "regular" operational and programmatic framework into the response framework
- 4. Sustain and build resilience
- 5. Plan, Respond, Recover, Mitigate
