



If you changed your Health Plan for 2022...



- Your 2022 Health Plan is now reflected in your CalPERS account under 'myCalPERS'.
- To view the Health Plan and your dependents enrolled for 2022, log in/register in myCalPERS account at www.calpers.ca.gov
- Health Plans have started to mail your new insurance cards.
- Your new health plan rates will be reflected on your 12/3/2021 earnings statement (paycheck).

Your Doctor and Medical Group



- Health Plans are continuing to mail Welcome Letters listing your Medical Group and Doctor.
- If you made a change to your Doctor, new insurance cards will be issued.
- If you were incorrectly assigned to a Medical Group and/or Doctor outside of the County, call your Health Plan to make the correction.
- To search for a Doctor online, make sure the Health Plan website link includes "/calpers" (ie. www.blueshieldca.com/calpers).

Be ProActive!



- Review your earnings statement dated 12/3/2021 to ensure your 2022 Open Enrollment transactions for health, dental, vision are correctly reflected.
- Review your earnings statement dated 1/14/2022 to ensure your 2022 Open Enrollment transactions for H-Care, D-Care, and Flexible Spending Account (FSA)/PayFlex are correctly reflected.
- Beneficiary designations are vital to ensuring your wishes are fulfilled in the event of death. Now is the time to submit an updated Beneficiary Form for the following applicable benefits (Basic Life Insurance, Supplemental Life Insurance, Deferred Compensation, PORAC, CLEA, CalPERS).
