

# Santa Cruz County Hearing Officer Recruitment



The County of Santa Cruz is seeking applicants for membership on a panel from which hearing officers will be selected to conduct administrative hearings and render written decisions regarding matters of the Santa Cruz County Code as assigned. Cases may include issues related to land-use, cannabis, tobacco, mobile home parks or street naming.

This panel will comprise up to five attorneys.

Hearing officers are currently paid \$125 per hour and must provide their own clerical support. Individuals interested in applying should send letters and resumes describing their particular qualifications by 5:00 P.M. on Friday, February 14, 2020.

## Minimum Qualifications

- Working knowledge of judicial procedures and the rules of evidence;
- Working knowledge of the principles of civil, constitutional and administrative law;
- Working knowledge of statutes and codes applicable to civil procedures;
- Some knowledge of precedent decisions concerning land use and/or rent control issues, cannabis issues, and/or tobacco sales restrictions;
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with County officials and the general public;
- Membership in the California State Bar and at least seven (7) years of full-time experience as an attorney practicing general civil law.
